

Absalon Strygekvarteret er et ungt ensemble dannet i 2020 med base i København.

Kvartetten har senest udmarket sig ved at vinde 1.prisen i P2's Kammermusikkonkurrence 2023. Kvartetten opnåede allerede anerkendelse, da de i 2021 vandt Rued Langgaard Konkurrencen og i den forbindelse spillede til åbningskoncerten af Rued Langgaard Festivalen samme år. Absalon Strygekvarteret har siden da med indlevelse og spilleglæde givet koncerter hos en stor del af Danmarks musikforeninger og koncertsale. Kvartetten har også med stor fornøjelse deltaget i mange internationale masterclasses bl.a med Den Danske Strygekvarteret, David Harrington (Kronos Quartet) som en del af Festspillene i Bergen, Eckart Runge (Artemis Quartet), Eberhard Feltz og senest med Minna Pensola (Meta4 Quartet) hos ProQuartet i Paris. Kvartetten arbejder med professor Tim Frederiksen på Det Kongelige Danske Musikkonservatorium i København. Absalon Strygekvarteret består af violinisterne Thera Ortved og Andreas Larsen, Alva Rasmussen på bratsch og Hedda Aadland på cello.

Absalon String Quartet is a young Copenhagen-based ensemble formed in 2020. The quartet quickly gained recognition in Denmark after they won the Rued Langgaard Competition in 2021 and played at the opening concert of the Rued Langgaard Festival in Ribe the same year. Since then the Absalon String Quartet has given concerts at a large part of Danmarks music associations and concert halls with great joy. ASQ has also taken part in many international masterclasses e.g. with David Harrington from the Kronos Quartet as part of the Festspillene in Bergen, with the Danish String Quartet at the DSQ Academy, Eberhard Feltz, Eckart Runge (Artemis Quartet) and most recently with Minna Pensola (Meta4 Quartet) at ProQuartet in Paris. In January 2023 the quartet won first prize at the prestigious Danish Radio Chamber Music Competition. The quartet works on a daily basis with Professor Tim Frederiksen at the Royal Danish Academy of Music in Copenhagen. ASQ consists of violinists Thera Ortved and Andreas Larsen, Alva Rasmussen on viola and Hedda Aadland on cello.
